A member of the Public commented on the map detailing the changes to the Village envelope as requested by the Parish Council

The Chairman commented that it had been considered that the original had been too tightly drawn , inaccurate and also , in places , did not make sense . . He also advised that much thought had been given to the revision which had also been the subject of Public consultation

It was AGREED that the Village envelope should be revisited in the future
